

Christmas Mystery Quilt





Read ALL cutting instructions CAREFULLY!!! These instructions are for ENTIRE quilt. Measure twice cut once! Be sure to label all of your pieces after you cut them - so that you can easily find them when you need them for each week! WOF = Width of Fabric



10" x WOF

Green Star: 1 - 9" x 9" square, cut twice diagonally (A) 
2 - 2" x 35" strips
sub-cut: 4 - 2" x 8" rectangles (B)
4 - 2" x 5" rectangles (C)



10" x 22"

Red Diamond: 1 - 9" x 9" square, cut twice diagonally (D) 
1 - 3 3/4" x 13" strip
sub-cut: 1 - 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" square cut twice diagonally (E) 
1 - 3" x 13" strip
sub-cut: 4 - 3" x 3" squares (F)





Red Star: 2 - 2 3/8" x WOF strips
sub-cut: 16 - 2 3/8" x 4 1/4" rectangles (G)



12" x WOF

Green Swirl: 2 - 2 3/8" x WOF strips
sub-cut: 16 - 2 3/8" x 4 1/4" rectangles (H)
1 - 2" x WOF strip
sub-cut - 4 - 2" x 6 1/4" rectangles (I)
sub-cut - 4 - 2" x 3 1/4" rectangles (J)
1 - 3" x WOF strip
sub-cut - 2 - 3" x 3" square cut once diagonally (K) 



5" x 22"

Holly: 1 - 3 3/4" x WOF strips
sub-cut: 2 - 3 3/4" squares, cut twice diagonally (L) 
sub-cut: 2 - 3" x 3" squares, cut once diagonally (M) 



4" x 22"

Brown Swirl: 1 - 2" x WOF strips
sub-cut: 4 - 2" x 2" squares (N)



12" x WOF

Red Snowflake: 4 - 2 3/4" x WOF strips
sub-cut: 2 - 2 3/4" x 32 3/8" strips (X)
sub-cut: 2 - 2 3/4" x 36 7/8" strips (Y)

White Star:


- 1 - 12" x WOF strip
subcut: 2 - 12" x 12" squares, cut twice diagonally **(O)** 
- 1 - 9" x WOF strips
subcut 2 - 9" x 9" squares, cut twice diagonally **(P)** 
2 - 6 5/8" x 6 5/8" squares, cut once diagonally **(Q)** 
- 4 - 2 3/8" x WOF strips
subcut: 64 - 2 3/8" x 2 3/8" squares **(R)**

- 4 - 2" x WOF strips
subcut: 46 - 2" x 2" squares **(S)**
8 - 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles **(T)**
8 - 2" x 2 7/8" rectangles **(U)**
8 - 2" x 1 3/8" rectangles **(V)**

Green Stripe: 4 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips - binding



Holly: Backing

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Peppermint Pinwheel Block



Red Star: G



Green Swirl: H




White Star: R




Take a G rectangle and place an R square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on your R square and stitch on that line. Trim 1/4" away from your seam and press. Do the same to the opposite side.

Make 16 red flying geese and 16 green units.




Sew your flying geese units in sets of two. With the green flying geese unit towards the top. Make 16 sets of two.

Should measure 4.25" x 4.25"



Sew two flying geese units into sets of two. As shown above. Make 8.



Sew units together - making sure you have the reds form a pinwheel in the center. Make 4.
Should measure 8" x 8"

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Green Star: C, B




White Star: S, T, U, V



Green Swirl: I, J




Brown Swirl: N




Take a J rectangle and place an S square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on your S square and stitch on that line. Trim 1/4" away from your seam and press. Do the same to the opposite side.

Sew a U rectangle to either side of your flying geese unit. Press. Should measure 2" x 8" Make 4.



Take a C rectangle and place an S square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on your S square and stitch on that line. Trim 1/4" away from your seam and press. Do the same to the opposite side.

Sew an S square to either side of your flying geese unit. Press. Should measure 2" x 8" - Make 4.



Take an I rectangle and place an S square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on your S square and stitch on that line. Trim 1/4" away from your seam and press. Do the same to the opposite side.


Sew a V rectangle to either side of your flying geese unit. Press. Should measure 2" x 8" - Make 4.



Take a B rectangle and place an S square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on your S square and stitch on that line. Trim 1/4" away from your seam and press. Do the same to the opposite side. Should measure 2" x 8" - Make 4.



Sew an N square in between two T rectangles. Should measure 2" x 8" - Make 4.



Take your pieced strips, and sew them together as pictured above. **Should measure 8" x 8"** Make 4.

Oh Christmas Tree




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Holly Jolly Hourglass




Red Diamond: D



Green Star: A




White Star: P



Take a P and an A triangle and sew together as pictured above.

Then sew a D and a P triangle together. Press triangles towards the dark fabric.



Sew your two triangle units together to make an hourglass block. **Trim to 8" x 8"**


Make 4 hourglass blocks.

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
Christmas Star




Red Diamond: F, E



Green Swirl: K




Holly: L, M




Take an M triangle and a K triangle and sew them together to form a half square triangle. Press to the dark side. Make 4.

Trim them to 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"

Now layout your pinwheel and sew into a 2 x 2 grid as pictured above. Trim to 4" x 4"




Take an F square and two L triangles. Sew a triangle to the right of your F square and then press. Then sew a triangle to the bottom of your F square. Press. Make 2 unit A's



Take an E triangle and L triangle and sew them together as pictured above. Make 2 unit B's and 2 unit C's

Sew a unit B to the left side of an F square. Press. Then sew a unit C to the bottom of the F square. Press. Make 2 unit D's



Sew a unit A to the top and bottom of your pinwheel. Press. Then sew a unit D to the right and left. Press. Should measure 8" x 8"
Make 1 Christmas Star Block.

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


Backing



Take your O triangles and sew your blocks into rows as pictured above. Once your blocks are in rows, sew the rows together. Press.



Once the rows are all sewn together, sew the Q triangles to each corner. Press.



Sew your X border strips to the left and right side. Press. Sew your Y strips to the top and bottom. Press.



Now you are ready to baste quilt and bind!
