

Pin-Tucked Pinwheel Blocks

Makes (2) 12" Finished Blocks

Use a total of 9 different prints for a scrappy look!

Cut -- (8) 7 1/2" squares: 4 light and 4 dark prints. Cut in half corner to corner. (Use 8 different prints for a scrappy look!)

Cut -- (8) 2 1/2" contrasting squares for center diamond. On the wrong side, draw line corner to corner (sewing line)

Sew together: 1 dark and 1 light print, right sides together, to form a half square triangle (HST).


Trim HST to 6 1/2 ".


Lay out HST blocks to form a pinwheel. (This is so you know which corner to add the dog ears.)


Place 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top corner of each HST as in diagram D. Sew on drawn line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press toward dog ear.

Sew 4 completed blocks together with dog ear corners meeting in the middle.

- (9) fat quarters = 8 blocks
- (9) 1/4 yard cuts = 10 blocks







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
