

45" x 45" Fort Worth Fabric Studio Designed by: Lindsey Weight

Read all instructions before starting. All seam allowances are 1/4". WOF = Width of fabric. HST = Half Square Triangle.

Supplies:

Fat Eighth of Navy Cluster 1/4 yard of Navy Tile 1/2 yard of Light Blue Floral 5/8 yard of White Floral 2 yards of background fabric 1/2 yard text (for binding) 3 yards for backing

Cutting:

From Navy Cluster:

4 - 3.5" squares (A) 1 - 5.5" x 5.5" Square (D)

From Navy Tile

4 - 6" squares (E)

From Light Blue Floral

8 - 6" squares (F)

From White floral

12 - 6" squares (G)

From background:

24 - 6" squares (H)

4 - 3" squares (C)


4 - 3.5" squares (B)

12 - 5.5" squares (I)


2.5" strips for border

From text:


5 - 2.5" x WOF strips for regular binding -or you can cut bias binding (you will have enough for whatever you decide).



Place an A square and a B square right sides together.




Mark a line from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.




With a rotatory cutter and ruler, cut along your marked line.




Press your half square triangles to the dark side. Make 8 half square triangles. Trim to 3" x 3"




Sew your half square triangle units in groups of two. On two of the sets, add a C square to the left and right side.




Sew the left and right units on your D square.




Sew the top and bottom strip on and press. Block should measure 10.5" x 10.5"



Place an E square and a H square right sides together.




Mark a line from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.




With a rotatory cutter and ruler, cut along your marked line.



Press your half square triangles to the dark side. Make 8 half square triangles. Trim to 5.5" x 5.5"










Make 16 Make 24


Following the same instructions as above you will make 16 half square triangles out of the light blue shark print and 24 half square triangles out of the white water print. You will trim all HSTs to 5.5" x 5.5"




Sew your half square triangle units into a 2 x 3 grid as pictured. You will make 4 of these units.










Sew your half square triangle units and 5.5" squares (I) into a 3 x 3 grids as pictured above.



Now place your blocks in a 3 x 3 grid and sew them into rows. Press. Then sew your rows together. Press. Should measure 40.5" x 40.5"

Now you are ready to add your border.

Measure the top and bottom of your quilt and cut 2 white strips 2.5" by width of your quilt. Sew a strip on the top and on the bottom. Press.

Now measure the left and right side. Cut 2 - 2.5" x length of quilt strips and sew on to your left and right side and press.

Now you are ready to baste, quilt and bind with your preferred methods.

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
